Abilities Possibilities Expo is a half day program where people with disabilities, their caregivers and healthcare providers can learn about options available to improve quality of life and increase independence all at one location, in one afternoon.

The event will be held at the Gulfcoast Event and Conference Center in Sarasota, Florida from 1:00 pm to 4:30 pm on Tuesday, February 14, 2012. The 4000 square foot exhibition hall will feature over 40 local and national companies and agencies who provide goods or services to the special needs community. Participants will have the opportunity to speak to representatives to learn about their products and services and to see and try their equipment or devices. There will also be free health screenings (vision, hearing, glucose, blood pressure, total cholesterol).

Door prizes will be awarded every half hour throughout the afternoon and there is a grand prize raffle for a \$500 Sears gift card at the end of the program.

The desired outcome is for the participants to leave the event with new ideas that they can explore further to enrich daily life and maximize their function and rehabilitation potential.
